Nit Alert!

Unfortunately, there are currently lots of nits in school. Please check your child's head regularly. Below are some links to websites which advocate various different treatments for lice: some natural and some chemical. You can now get a prescription from your doctor for the treatment of lice too.

We are not allowed to exclude children who have lice from school, all we can do is remind their parents and whanau to check and treat. We also educate the children about head lice. Children need to avoid head to head contact with other children and alert the adults at home as soon as they suspect they have lice. When treating your child using whichever method you prefer, it is advisable to treat the whole family, including parents and even grandparents if they have regular contact with the kids.



Walk for the ones we love as we raise funds for breast cancer awareness, research and education.


