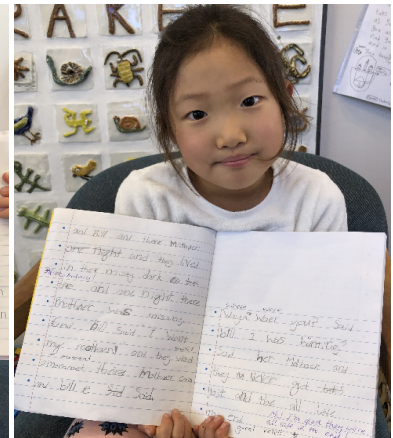
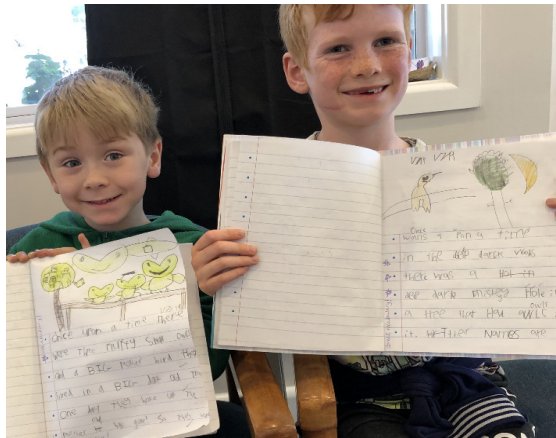
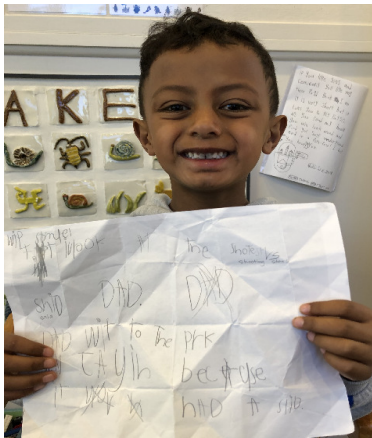
### Thank you to our Parent Group!

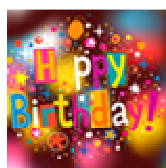

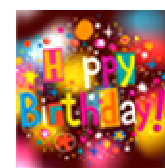
