Send your old mobile phones along to school, so they can be recycled. A box is in the main foyer to collect the phones.

Scheme recycling agent Swapkit New Zealand collects and sorts the phones into those which can be re-used and those which are end-of-life. Reusable phones are sold by tender overseas while end-of-life phones are deconstructed, commoditised and their components used to create other products.

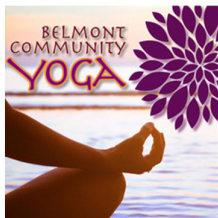
