Tuakana Teina Projects

Last week, as part of our Kāhui Ako (Community of Learning) our senior students walked to Takapuna Grammar School to share their speeches with their buddies. Each one of our senior children is paired with an older mentor (tuakana) with whom they share their writing on line through their google document. The older students give our children feedback on how they can improve their writing. On this occasion, they were actually getting together to work on speeches.









As well as having a tuakana to help them, some of our seniors act as tuakana to younger students at Bayswater. They are trained to work with their younger buddies and take their responsibilities very seriously. There is also time to have some fun together!







IMPORTANT NOTICE

NOTICE OF SCHOOL CLOSING 15TH AUGUST – TOMORROW

School will be closed on Wednesday 15th August as almost all of the teaching staff and the principal will be taking action in support of their negotiations with the Ministry of Education. This means that children will need to be kept home for the day. The decision to close the school has been made by the Board of Trustees and is to ensure the safety of all children.

The main points of the teachers' and principals' claims are concerned with recruitment and retention of quality teachers and support for children with additional needs.

We are fortunate at Bayswater School to have a settled and committed staff. This is not the case in all schools, some of which have not been able to recruit suitable teachers and have had to split classes bringing numbers up to 45 children in one class. Even we have experienced difficulties in the recent past, covering parental leave and roll growth classes. We currently have difficulty finding relievers to cover classes when teachers are sick or away on courses.

Bayswater is an inclusive school and welcomes children of all achievement levels and physical abilities. This can present challenges when insufficient support is available to address the needs of some of our children. They miss out on valuable learning and staff are placed under additional stress.

The Board of Trustees and the teachers appreciate that the day of action will inconvenience many families. We have been informed by Kelly Club that they will be open during the day.


