"We currently have a number of male volunteers being screened, and they will soon become available to be a mentor to a boy in your area. Is there a boy at your school who will benefit from being involved with the programme? We accept boys who are aged between 7-14, (Little Buddies), who do not have a father/male role model in their lives. It is simply a good man turning up each week in a boy's life (2-3 hours on a weekend), exploring the world together, being available to listen and giving him the experience of an older man who cares, similar to a positive uncle."

### A message from the Ministry of Education...

The Ministry of Education is co-ordinating wānanga to be led by community leaders / facilitators across Tamaki Makaurau. It is hoped that we will identify community members who will continue to Wānanga with us following these hui and to inform the kōrero (see below).

Kōrero Mātauranga – Education Conversation is the website that is being used to capture the 18 different reviews that are taking place at the moment. There are some themes that are emerging through that will inform the Minister of Education on the Education Work Programme.

The Māori Wānanga will be focussed on capturing 'authentic Māori voice' to inform the future design of New Zealand education for all children and young people for the next 30 years. This will feed into the refresh of Ka Hikitia and Tau mai te Reo, and the Education Work Programme (attached).

The Ministry of Education is inviting all whānau, hapū, iwi - tamariki, mātua and kaumātua – to help build the future of Māori education in Aotearoa. I have attached an invite for you to share with whānau.

We are asking you to help us ensure that Māori-Whānau within your school and community have their say.

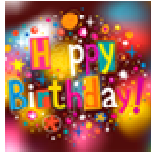


## Wednesday 19th September

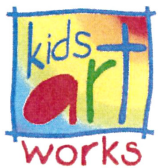
