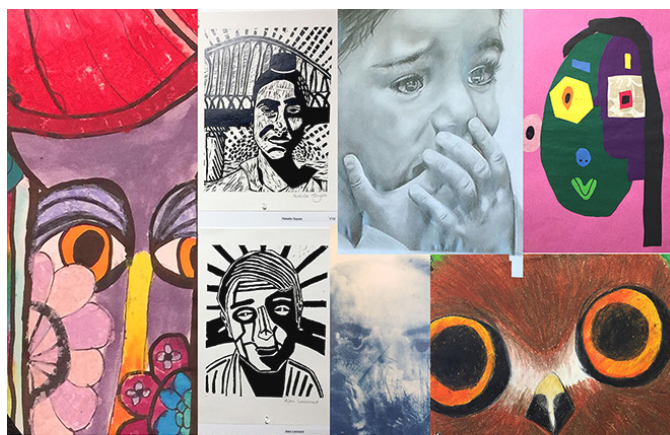
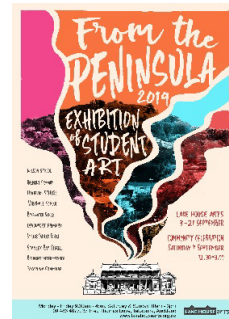
To launch this initiative, ten children joined me last week and we enjoyed a delicious morning tea together. The next morning tea will be on the last Friday of term.

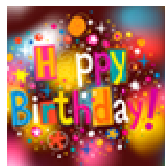

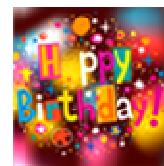
