Board of Trustees News

The Bayswater School Board of Trustees met regularly during the rāhui lockdown. The normal meeting schedule of ordinary meetings (to discuss teaching and learning, finance and property) and self-review meetings was postponed to focus on the school's response to the Covid-19 crisis. The board supported the senior leadership team as we developed risk mitigation plans for the various levels and did their utmost to promote equity during the learning from home period. With the Board's blessing, the school distributed Chromebooks for families to use at home where there were insufficient devices for the children to access their distance learning.

Since level 2, the Board has met once. We have decided to continue to meet remotely for the time being as many of us enjoy being able to wear our pyjamas for meetings! The Board is currently discussing its next community consultation. We will be contacting all of you very soon to gain a better insight into your hopes and aspirations for your children's learning whilst they are at primary school. 
Looking for Local Knitter






