Reminder About Sick Children

If your child is unwell and has symptoms which could be consistent with Covid-19, please keep him / her off school. Ministry advice is that symptoms are: cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing or temporary loss of smell. Children who develop any of these symptoms at school, need to be collected straight away by a parent or caregiver. We do appreciate how difficult this is for some families but we have been urged by the Ministries of Education and Health to err on the side of caution.

Children are still being asked to wash their hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser prior to eating and regularly throughout the day.
