Steve commented, "The average age of the Ngataringa Bay North West Wildlink pest control crew dropped considerably on the weekend with the addition of Leo and Alice into the ranks.

As well as setting and restocking the 13 rat bait stations around the bay, Leo and Alice also participated in a mini beach clean-up and perfected the art of blue gloved jazz hands."


