#### Haere Mai and Welcome!

#### This Term's Learning

In Health and PE this term, the children will be focusing on cross-country running. I know that Whānau Wai and Kokoru (middle and senior school) always welcome help with cross-country training so look out for details in the syndicate newsletters. For all of the children, it is important that appropriate clothing and shoes are worn on running days – it is hard to do your best when you are trying to run in gum boots!

In Learning Pathways, the children will continue to explore their own family histories and the diversity we have in our school, this term through the medium of visual art. They will be learning about various different artistic techniques and using these to produce artworks reflecting their learning. Some of the pieces will be exhibited later in the year at a joint Peninsula schools art show at the Lake House. The show will include work from all school in the Kahui Ako or Community of Learning (Bayswater, Takapuna Grammar, Belmont Intermediate, Belmont Primary, Vauxhall, Devonport and Stanley Bay).

The fourth week of term (from 22<sup>nd</sup> May) is Pink Shirt Week, an international week when there is a focus on bullying – prevention, what to do if it happens to you and what to do if you are aware of it happening to someone else. During the last three weeks of term (from 19<sup>th</sup> June) we will be running Keeping Ourselves Safe in conjunction with the Police Service. This teaches children a range of safety skills that they can use when interacting with others.

There will be more information about this programme sent home in the coming weeks.



#### Whānau Mārama Parenting

The Whānau Mārama Parenting course will be running in the school hall on Thursdays from the 25<sup>th</sup> May to 15<sup>th</sup> June from 9:30 to 10:30am. Tamati, from Whānau Mārama, will be talking about the course in assembly this Friday so why not come along to hear more about it? The course will be offered free of charge and sounds like it will be extremely useful. We have made it for 9:30 so that participants can drop their children to class and pop to the staffroom for a coffee before starting. Enrolments will be available from Irene or Fiona at the office.

#### Matariki 2017

After two successful years (the hāngi in 2015 and the boil-up last year) we are keen to celebrate Matariki again this year. We are thinking of having another hāngi but, as always, will need lots of help from all of you with skills and knowledge to share. This will be organised for the end of Pipiri (June) around week 8 or 9. More information to follow shortly.

We are excited to be developing plans to start regular harakeke weaving at school. Local weaver, Jude Hoani, will be joining us at assembly on Friday and will then start making pāro (bowls) for Matariki. She would be delighted to be joined by any whānau interested in helping. No experience of weaving is necessary - this will be a fantastic opportunity to develop new skills! Experienced weavers are also very welcome!

#### Te Po Toru - Third Week Wednesday 24th May


#### **Dance/fitness Class**
