## Whānau Puna Swimming Sports

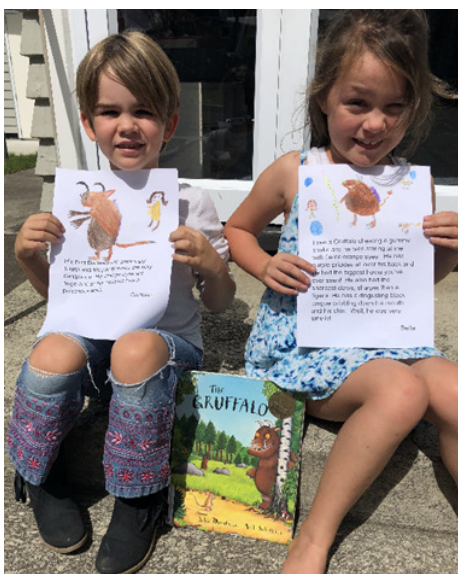
This was a great celebration of what the children have been learning this term. Some of the activities showed their developing water confidence.

### Great Writers

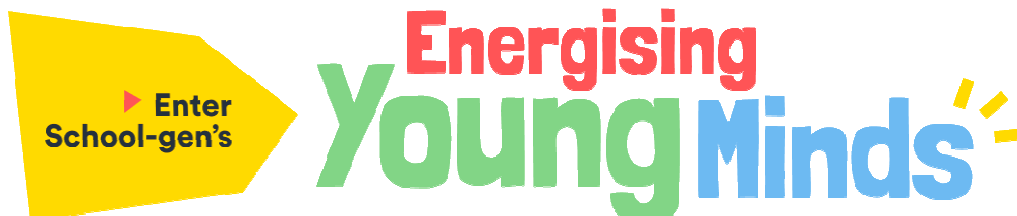
