Mathematics Leadership Day

It was a pleasure last week to welcome staff from across the Peninsula to a Mathematics Leadership Day which we hosted. Marianne and Megan attended from Bayswater and were joined by colleagues from Takapuna Grammar School, Belmont Intermediate School, Stanley Bay, Belmont Primary, Vauxhall and Devonport.

The group spent the day talking about teaching and learning of mathematics and covered topics such as keeping children engaged and achieving in mathematics; features of effective lessons and developing a positive mathematical mindset in children.

After school, we hosted workshops which were attended by 50+ teachers from across the Kahui Ako. These covered the teaching of mathematics number knowledge at different stages and levels.
